MEPTEC and SMTA will co-produce Medical Electronics Symposium

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn.—The SMTA and MEPTEC will co-produce a 2009 Medical Electronics Symposium, scheduled for September 23-24 on the Tempe campus of Arizona State University. ASU's College of Nursing and Healthcare Innovation will co-sponsor the event.

The SMTA Medical Electronics Symposium was previously held in Anaheim, Calif. and Minneapolis and is in its sixth year. MEPTEC's symposium is in its fourth year and has been held previously at ASU.



Each organization will organize complementary one-day tracks of technical presentations to be held on successive days. Attendees will have the option of attending both days of the program or of buying a one-day pass to attend the individual sessions.

The symposium will cover development, reliability, and quality of medical electronics, materials processing and medical electronics assembly, battery technology, environmental- and worldwide regulation.
