motions. Before submitting an article, please query the editor by e-mail at roniscoff@gmail.com with a brief summary of the proposed article (100 words or less).

With few exceptions, articles must be exclusive to *MicroConnections*. Most articles will be used in both the print edition and the digital edition. If you wish us to consider an article that is based on a paper presented at a conference, you must, before we enter into production, secure permission from the conference sponsor. Typical article length is 500-1000 words with four good graphics (minimum) and a photo and bio of the author. Article preference will be given to topics that fit our editorial calendar.

Article copyrights must be transferred to *MicroConnections*, and a form for authors is available. After publication, the author (or company) will receive a license in perpetuity to use the article in its original format, for any purpose, prior to editing and layout by *MicroConnections*.

News is accepted on a non-exclusive basis. By submitting news releases, companies agree that *MicroConnections* has unrestricted permission to edit, shorten or rewrite any news to fit *MicroConnections* format and style.
